Trains

Nottingham is right in the centre of the country and well connected to all other major cities by the train network.

Regular services operate between Nottingham and London St Pancras (from 1 hours 45 mins), Birmingham (1 hour 15 mins), Leeds (2 hours), Manchester (2 hours), or Sheffield (1 hour).

Jubilee campus is approx. 2 miles from Nottingham train station a 40 min walk or a short bus ride.

Bus service from Nottingham Train Station to Jubilee Campus

There are no buses direct from Nottingham Train Station to the Jubilee Campus. There are however buses from Nottingham Bus Station in the Victoria Centre. This is approximately a 16 minute walk across the city centre from the train station or you can use the tram or free Centrelink bus to get around the city Centre.

The Pink Line buses numbers 28 and 30 both stop outside Jubilee Campus on Wollaton Road and also serve the main halls of residence along Ilkeston Road:

- The No 28 runs every 7-10 minutes on Monday to Saturday daytimes
- The no 30 runs every 15 minutes on Monday to Saturday daytimes
- Every 10 minutes on Sunday daytimes
- Every 15 minutes Monday to Saturday evenings

Travel from East Midlands Airport

- a) From East Midlands Airport to Broad Marsh Bus Station Nottingham **Approx 35 mins**
Costs vary depending on date and time but c£4.10 single
Frequency every 3-4 hours

Travel from Heathrow Airport

There are several options to travel to Nottingham from Heathrow airport

- b) Heathrow Underground from Terminal 1,2,3
Take the Piccadilly line to London Kings Cross, St Pancras. Then take a direct train from St Pancras to Nottingham (hourly service **approx. 1hr 45 mins**)
OR
From Kings Cross take the train to Grantham change at Grantham for Nottingham
Approx time 3 hours 5 mins
Prices will vary depending on time travelled – likely to be **from** £71 return off-peak

- c) From Heathrow Central Bus Station Stand 8 take the 230 coach to Broad Marsh Bus Station Nottingham **Approx 3 – 4hours**
Costs vary depending on date and time but c£30.00 single

Travel from Birmingham Airport

- a) Birmingham International airport to Birmingham New Street change for Nottingham
Approx time 1 hour 45mins
Prices will vary depending on time travelled – likely to be **from** £25 return off-peak
